Autumn Weather

As we have now entered the season which brings us much wetter weather, it would be very helpful if parents could dress their child in leggings/jogging trousers. This will make it easier for the children and staff getting our outdoor waterproof trousers and jackets on and off for our regular visits to our outdoor play area. Please remember there are toilet visits to bear in mind and the children struggle with tights & dresses with their waterproofs, so the simpler the better, to make our transition from indoors to outdoors and vice versa as smooth as possible. We would appreciate it if everybody could leave a named pair of wellies by your child's peg, along with their indoor shoes. Hopefully we can all enjoy exploring outside in all weathers with the necessary clothes for our changing weather.

P.E / Fitness

We will continue to have Fitness with Mrs Nicolson on a Wednesday and P.E with Mrs Dodson is now on a Friday for the nursery children. From time to time the days may change, so if possible, please leave your child's bag containing their P.E kit on their peg – please remember, no drawstring bags or plastic bags for safety reasons. Please can we remind everyone to name clothes, shoes and wellies as we have recently had some unplanned swapping of clothes. The children have a habit of spreading out when changing and they do not always recognise their own clothes, so unnamed items cause confusion when trying to give clothes back to the right child.

Pre-5 Fund

The £10 termly Pre-5 fund money will be due when we return after the October holiday. Please hand this to a member of staff on our return. Thank you.

Lunches

Please can we ask that parents sending in packed lunches remember that we are unable to allow products containing nuts, due to allergies in the school. We are aware that many cereal bars contain nuts or may have traces of nuts so please be careful when choosing these bars. Please leave bars in the

wrappers to help us. Please can we also ask that grapes and tomatoes plus similar shaped foods are appropriately sliced to prevent any choking hazards. Thank you.

Pre-5/P1 Liaison

As part of the transition programme the Pre-school children will continue to work with Mrs Hendry and P1. Our pre-school children will visit P1 for two, time-tabled sessions per week where they will work on health outcomes following the PATHS programme. This started in September once all of the new children had settled into school. The PATHS programme is a programme which promotes alternative thinking strategies.
