Termly Reports

Parents Evening

We plan to hold our first Parents Evening with you on **Tuesday 2nd November**. At the present time it is our intention to hold this virtually (unless guidance should change in the meantime). We will be in touch with appointment times after the break.

Staffing

There will be some slight changes to the staffing timetable starting after the October break. In P3/4 Mrs Hendry will be teaching Mon-Wed and Miss Lindsay will teach the class on a Thurs/Fri. I will spend some time teaching each class with the main focus of my remit being Spanish and PE. Assemblies will also be reinstated on alternating weeks for P1-4 then P5-7.

Children will continue to have Music with Mrs Ridland once a fortnight and French with Mrs Dodson weekly. As part of the Education Scotland Language 1+ 2 approach children should have the opportunity to learn more than one additional language at Primary School. Previously most of the children have learned some Gaelic at school with P7 also learning some Mandarin through the Confucius Institute.

As there has been little change to guidance for schools celebrations for Halloween will form a similar format to last year with parties held within classes during the school day. We are also planning an additional outdoor spooky trail within the school grounds.
