<p><u>Languages</u> Literacy and English Reading Writing Talking and Listening Modern Languages French Spanish</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Personal choice books and a quiz completed on AR. - Reading for information within class topic. - Blue/Green Reading box for comprehension. <p><u>Writing</u> – spelling and phonics using Single Word Spelling and common words. Personal writing – holiday writing; experiences; outdoor learning; trips. Imaginative – developing use of adjectives and adverbs; similes; speech marks. Informative – linked with ICT; powerpoints; fact files/research; facts and opinions.</p> <p><u>Talking and Listening</u> – presenting powerpoints/learning to the class; group and class discussions.</p>
<p><u>Mathematics</u> Numbers, money and measure Shape, position and movement Data Handling</p>	<p>Sumdog – different challenges will be set according to class learning and used for homework. Mental Maths – strategies; written daily questions to improve speed and accuracy; mathematical vocabulary; using the 4 operations; revisits every area of maths. Number – Fractions, decimals and percentages; multiples and factors; equations and patterns. Problem Solving – applying problem solving strategies</p>

<p><u>Technologies</u> Craft and Design I.C.T</p>	<p>ICT – iMovie; stop-motion; coding; research skills; STEM – making a model wind turbine; electrical circuits; coding</p>
<p><u>Sciences</u></p>	<p>Friction; Reducing Friction; Action and Reaction; Electrical Circuits; Series and Parallel Circuits; Energy Transformation; Storing Energy</p>
<p><u>Religious and moral education</u> Other World Religions and Beliefs</p>	<p>Christianity – Parables of Jesus Islam - Eid Morals linked with Health/PATHS</p>
<p><u>Expressive Arts</u> Art and design Music Drama</p>	<p><u>Music</u> – rhythms, singing, orchestra/choir; musical games linked to health <u>Art</u> – linked to topic. <u>Drama</u> – role play;</p>
<p><u>Health and wellbeing</u> P.E. Health Mental, emotional, social and physical wellbeing</p>	<p>PE – summer games; badminton skills; sports day; general fitness Responsible: food journeys; impact on environment; food marketing and advertising Included: interests in and out of school; benefits of taking part in sport or physical activity.</p>
<p><u>Homework</u></p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Spelling: Words will be sent home to be practised each week. Reading: personal reader at home – quizzes to be completed on AR when the book is finished (this can be done at home or in school). <u>Maths</u></p>
