This term Primary 6/7 will be working on the following themes and topics:

Curriculum Area	Topic: Business Enterprise
<u>Languages</u> Literacy and English Reading Writing Talking and Listening Modern Languages French	<i>Reading:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Class novel – The Final Year• Individual reading: AR books, Reading Box, websites related to class topic (e.g. well known entrepreneurs). <i>Writing:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All writing will be topic based: market research (creating a questionnaire); completing a job application; email – keeping stakeholders informed; taking minutes in meetings; creating agendas; designing adverts; creating order forms; create planning charts with clear deadlines; layout of a letter, including appropriate formal words to use.• Imaginary pieces will be based around Christmas and Hallowe'en <i>Talking and listening:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Current affairs, topic videos, presentations and debates. <i>Spelling:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Topic related words, Nessler spelling; and continuation of core spelling programme. <p>The French online lessons will continue on a weekly basis. Months of the year; Birthdays; Colours; Family; Pets; Description; Phonics.</p>
<u>Numeracy</u>	<p>Numeracy outcomes will be linked to the class topic: Business Enterprise within the topics of Number, Money and Data Analysis.</p> <p>For more detail for each group see inside the back of your child's diary.</p> <p>The children who are participating in the Maths Challenge this year will complete set 2 of the problems</p> <p>Whole class strategies: Look for a pattern; Work Backwards</p> <p>Please see your child's numeracy planning section in their diary for more detail.</p>
<u>Social Studies</u>	<p>Business Enterprise will be the main focus: by experiencing the setting up and running of a business the children will collaborate in making choices related to the different roles and responsibilities and evaluate their success.</p> <p>Virgin Money will lend each child £5 to start their business. The children can choose to work individually or as part of a team. The aim is to make as much profit as they can.</p>
<u>ICT/Technologies</u> <u>STEM</u>	<p>Design a logo for P6/7 Enterprise company; Design posters to market Enterprise company; Create marketing video adverts for Enterprise company; Create catalogue of goods for sale; Keep a spreadsheet of orders; Keep a record of money coming in and money going out.</p> <p>STEM Tbc - depending on children's choice of Enterprise</p> <p>Hallowe'en enquiry: origami bats, painted stones, tissue paper jars, clay pumpkins, face painting designs.</p> <p>Christmas: Props and backdrops for the performance of Bah Humbug!</p>
